Rotary Establishments: Rotary International has various rotary establishments in Delhi and NCR namely Dr. B.R. Ambedkar - Institute Rotary Cancer Hospital, Rotary Public School, Rotary Blood Bank & Rotary Eye Care Centre, Rotary Habitat Centre, Rotary Diabetes Centre and Rotary Transfusion Centre etc.
